

Day One

Leaving from the Treviso airport at 15.30 pm, we'll arrive at 17 pm at the "El Prat" Airport.

We'll pass the rest of the afternoon and the evening enjoying **Plaça de Catalunya**, a large square in the centre of Barcelona, especially known for its fountains and statues, then we'll continue up to the **Rambla**, the popular street very appreciated by the tourists.

The night will finish in **Port Vell**, the old harbour of Barcelona that at this moment of the day is very attractive.



Day Two

Today we'll see some important monuments.

At 10 am we'll visit **Casa Batlló**, located in the famous area called "The Apple of Discord"; after this we'll see **Casa Amatller**, a building originally designed as a residence for Antoni Amatller.



In the late afternoon, we'll dedicate our time admiring the **Sacred Family**, the basic element of Barcelona and that forms part of the urban scenery, the culture of the country.

Day Three

On our third day we'll start visiting the **Estadi Olímpic**, originally built in 1927 for the 1929 International Exposition in the city; in the early afternoon we'll discover Joan Miró world, in his museum, the **Fundació Joan Miró**.

We'll continue up to the **Montjuïc hill**, ready to observe its enchanting castle.



Day Four

On our fourth day we'll start our tour with the **Església de Santa Maria del Mar**, an imposing church in the Ribera district of Barcelona; then the **Picasso Museum**, a museum that reveals Picasso's relationship with the city of Barcelona, that was shaped in his youth and adolescence, and continued until his death.

All the afternoon is free for shopping in **Mercat de Santa Caterina** and then we'll go in **Parc de la Ciutadella**, a park in Ciutat Vella whose main attraction is the zoo.

Our day will end admiring the **Arc de Triomf**, a structure that was built for the Exposición Universal de Barcelona.

Day Five

An immersion into the history of the city visiting the **Museu d'Història de Catalunya**, then we'll pass most of the day in **Playa de la Barceloneta**, the oldest and the most famous of the city beaches in Spain.

Finally the **Aquarium Barcelona**, located in Port Vell, will be our last stop for the day.

Day Six

Camp Nou, the famous football stadium of the Barcelona football team, will take us two hours to visit.

We will visit the **Gaudí House-Museum** in the early afternoon, then **Parc Güell** for the rest of the evening enjoying Gaudí's masterpieces in this particular park located inside the Museum House Gaudí.



Day Seven

A whole morning for preparing our luggage and to buy the last things, then at half past eleven we'll take the "Aerobus" up to the airport, for our flight home.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Round-trip tickets (**Ryanair**): € 40.
- Departure at 15.30 from the Treviso airport, you need to be there at least 2 hours early.
- Accommodation at the **Hostal Campi**, double-bed room and twin room with toilet/shower from 30.00€ to 35.50 per person (breakfast and dinner included, lunch always excluded).
- **Prices** of the various **museums/attractions**: Casa Battló €14,25 – Sacred Family €12,00 – Fundació Joan Miró €8,50 – Camp Nou €17,00 – Gaudí House-Museum €5,50 – Picasso Museum €9,00 – Museu d'Història de Catalunya €5,00 – Aquarium Barcelona €17,50.
