Survey on work experience and report

Livello linguistico: Intermediate (B1)

LESSON PLAN

1. PRESENTATION

After having discussed in class, during the very first lessons in September, the 3 week work experience all students had at the end of the previous school year, students are asked to prepare six questions each about the experience for a possible survey.

2. GROUP WORK

Students divide into groups of 3 and are asked to write 10 questions for a possible survey organized by the firm/ association which had hosted some of them and which wants feedback about this activity. The questions must include topics such as timetable, location of placement, tasks and duties, competence acquired at school and new skills, and be both open or multiple choice .

The teacher collects all the questions and formulates a survey with 10 questions. Students are asked to take the survey and send in their answers online. The results are then viewed on the class platform in graphic form (pie charts).

3. The teacher explains how to write a report, how to describe charts and uploads examples and tips on the platform.

4. In groups of 3 students are asked to write about the facts/statistics of the survey and to write a complete report (including recommendations) on the work experience for the Head of Human Resources of the firm which commissioned the survey.

4. EVALUATION

Students are asked to orally report the findings and discuss their personal experience in detail.
